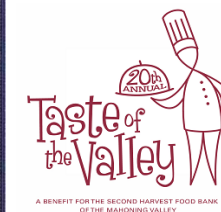

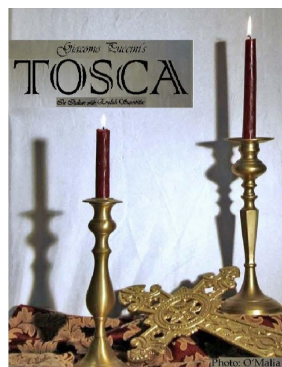

## HENRY H. STAMBAUGH YOUTH CONCERT BAND WINTER CONCERT

Henry H. Stambaugh Youth Concert Band

The Henry H. Stambaugh Youth Concert Band begins its 11th season with auditions on Tuesday, September 13. Rehearsals begin on Tuesday, September 20 and continue each Tuesday evening culminating in the Annual Winter Band Concert on Wednesday, November 30 at 7:30 p.m. in the historic Concert Hall of Stambaugh Auditorium. The Youth Band traditionally averages between 80 and 90 high school student musicians from an eight county area in Northeastern Ohio and Western Pennsylvania. This represents approximately 30 school district band programs. An outstanding Youth Band senior is chosen through auditions to perform as a senior soloist with the band each year and the Barbara Armstrong Memorial Youth Band Scholarship is presented each spring to a deserving graduating senior who plans to pursue music at the collegiate level. John Veneskey serves as conductor and Thomas A. Groth as Executive Director of the Youth Band. Guest conductors, ensemble coaches and students from the Dana School of Music at Youngstown State University also assist in providing quality band performances and musically challenging experiences for the members of the Band.
